## I. 목적

외국인 학생에게 대한민국의 고등교육기관에서 수학할 기회를 부여함으로써 국제교육교류를 촉진하고 국가 간 우호증진을 도모하고자 함

- 2017년 9월 1일 기준 만 40세 미만인 자 (1977년 9월 1일 이후 출생자)
- 2017년 초청대상국의 ODA 수원국의 현직 교수는 2017년 9월 1일 기준 만 45세 미만인 자 (1972년 9월 1일 이후 출생자)

- 2017년 8월 31일 기준 학위를 소지하고 있거나 취득 예정인 정부초청 장학생은 다음의 조건에 한해 지원 가능
  - 출신국가 주재 한국대사관을 통해서만 지원 가능
  - 재지원은 1회에 한해 허용

#### 4. 성적

- 최종학교 전(全)학년 성적 평균 평점(GPA)이 다음의 조건 중 하나 이상을 충족하는 자
  - 4.0 만점에 2.64 이상
  - 4.3 만점에 2.80 이상
  - 4.5 만점에 2.91 이상
  - 5.0 만점에 3.23 이상
  - 백분율 환산 점수: 80% 이상
- 성적의 백분율 환산은 Appendix A. GPA 환산표 참고
- 위의 기준에 미달되는 지원자는 심사대상에서 제외됨
- 제출 성적표에 평균평점에 대한 정보가 기재되어 있지 않거나, 성적을 GPA 백분율로 환산하기 어려운 경우 출신대학의 성적에 대한 공식적인 설명자료가 필요함

#### 5. 건강상태

- 한국에서의 장기간 유학이 가능할 정도로 심신이 건강한 자
- 지원 시 자가건강체크리스트(Personal Medical Assessment)를 반드시 제출
- 2차 심사 합격자들은 반드시 종합건강검진을 받아야 하며 그 결과를 NIIED에 제출해야 함
- 다음의 지원자들은 최종 선발에서 제외되며, 최종 선발된 이후라도 합격이 취소됨
  - 마약복용 판정을 받은 자
  - 그 외 장기간 수학이 어렵다고 판단되는 질병을 가진자
- 위 조건을 충족하는 장애인 지원자는 지원 가능

#### 6. 지원 제한

- 정부초청외국인 장학생으로 선발되었다가 포기한 적이 있는 자는 지원 불가

#### 7. 우대사항

- 한국어능력성적(TOPIK) 또는 영어능력성적(TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS Academic) 취득자는 선발전형에서 우대되어질 수 있으며, 해당자에 한해 제출. 기관 TOEFL 등 효력이 제한적인 어학능력 시험은 고려되지 않음.

- 산업전문인력 역량강화 사업 학위과정 지원자는 동등자격 또는 심사결과 성적이 동점일 시 우선선발

## 2. 주의사항

- 모든 제출 서류는 한국어 혹은 영어로 작성되어야 함
- 한국어 혹은 영어가 아닌 문서는 반드시 한글 또는 영문 공증번역본으로 제출하여야 함
- 모든 제출 서류는 복사본이 아닌 원본이어야 함
- 지원 시 제출한 서류 및 기록물 일체는 반환하지 않음
- 지원자는 제출 서류를 지원서 첫 페이지에 있는 체크리스트 순서대로 정렬하여 제출해야 함.  
각 서류의 오른쪽 상단에는 체크리스트 상의 번호와 제목을 기재하여야 함
  - 예: 9. 학사 학위 증명서 원본
- 부득이하게 사본을 제출할 수밖에 없는 경우에는, 반드시 공증이나 아포스티유 혹은 영사 확인을 받아 제출해야 함
- 원본 재발급이 불가능한 문서의 경우에는 공증 혹은 영사 확인을 받은 사본을 제출할 것
- 제출서류의 기재내용이 사실과 다르거나 구비서류가 미흡한 지원서는 심사에서 제외되며 불합격 처리됨
- 졸업예정자는 졸업예정증명서를 제출하며 2017년 8월 31일까지 공식 졸업증을 제출해야 함
- 추천서는 지원자의 학업능력을 평가할 수 있는 2명의 추천인에게 받아야 함.
- 추천서는 추천인이 봉투에 서명, 밀봉하여 지원자에게 전달해야 함. 봉인되지 않은 추천서는 효력이 없음.
- 연구논문이나 서적, 그리고 수상내역 등은 사본을 제출해도 무방함
- 국적 증빙자료는 출신국 정부에서 발행한 문서여야 하며, 다음 중 하나를 제출하여도 무방함.
  - 지원자의 출신 국가 정부에서 발행한 출생증명서 원본
  - 지원자의 출신 국가 정부에서 발행한 가족관계증명서 원본

## VI. 선발절차

### 1. 지원서 제출

- 2017년도 지원자는 재외공관 또는 국내위탁대학 둘 중 하나를 통해서만 지원해야 함
- 지원서 접수 기관
  - **116개 재외공관 (대사관)**: 한국교육원 혹은 문화원이 있는 일부 국가에서는 공관 대신 한국교육원이나 문화원에서 지원서를 접수하기도 함
  - **65개 국내위탁대학**
- 위 기관 중 두 곳 이상에, 중복 지원한 지원자는 불합격 처리됨
- 해외입양인도 입양인 배정인원이 배정된 국가의 한국대사관을 통해서만 지원가능. II-1-(2)의 표에 기재된 국가의 국적소지자만 지원 가능
- KGSP 장학생이나 졸업생은 한국대사관을 통해서만 지원가능
- 중국 및 체코지원자는 협정에 따라 자국 교육부에서 1차 선발함. 지원서를 자국 교육부에 제출

### 2. 지원서 제출 마감일

- 마감일은 지원서 접수 기관인 대사관이나 대학이 결정
- 지원자는 본인이 지원을 희망하는 기관의 마감일을 반드시 확인해야 함

#### 4. 선발절차

##### 1차 심사

추천기관(공관, 대학)에서 원서를 접수하여 선발기준(NIIED)에 근거 심사 후 후보 추천

- 공관과 대학에서 1차 심사 통과자의 지원서를 2017년 4월 7일까지 NIIED로 송부
- **주의사항:** 위 기한 내 도착하지 않은 지원서는 2차 심사에서 제외되며, 이로 인해 발생하는 여분의 배정인원은 다른 공관/ 대학에 배정됨

##### 2차 심사

1차 선정 후 추천된 후보자들을 대상으로 NIIED의 “장학생 선정위원회”에서 종합심사

- 2차 심사를 통과한 대학전형 지원자는 지망학교에 입학이 확정. 장학생으로 최종 선발되기 위해서는 반드시 건강검진 결과를 제출해야 함
- 종합건강검진
  - 2차 심사를 통과한 모든 지원자는 NIIED가 제공하는 양식에 맞춰 건강검진을 받아야 하며, 그 결과를 NIIED에 제출해야 함

- Korean citizens, including those who hold dual citizenship, are NOT eligible to apply.
- Applicants and their parents who had previously held Korean citizenship must submit the document of the renunciation of their Korean citizenship.

### 2. Age

- Applicants must be under 40 years of age as of September 1, 2017 (born after September 1, 1977).
- An applicant who qualifies ALL conditions below is eligible to apply as long as he or she is under 45 years of age as of September 1, 2017 (born after September 1, 1972):
  - He or she must be working as a professor at the time of applying; and
  - He or she is a citizen of one of the countries below.

### 3. Degree Requirements

- Applicants must hold a Bachelor's or Master's degree as of August 31, 2017.
  - A Bachelor's degree, or a diploma equivalent to a Bachelor's degree, is required for a Master's program applicant.
  - A Master's degree, or a diploma equivalent to a Master's degree, is required for a Doctoral program applicant.
- The Research Program applicants must hold a degree, or a diploma equivalent to or higher than a Master's degree as of August 31, 2017.
  - **Postdoctoral Research Program:** A Doctoral degree, or a diploma equivalent to a Doctoral degree, is required.
  - **Professor Exchange Program:** A Master's degree, or a diploma equivalent to or higher than a Master's degree, is required.
- An Applicant who is expected to obtain the official diploma by August 31, 2017 must submit a certificate of expected degree at the time of applying. The official diploma must be submitted as soon as it is issued.
- Applicants who have completed a Bachelor's, Master's or Doctoral degree in Korea are NOT eligible to apply. This restriction does not apply for Overseas Korean Adoptee applicants.

- Applicants who have been enrolled at Korean universities as exchange students are eligible to apply.
- A former KGSP scholar who graduated or are expected to graduate as of August 31, 2017 is eligible to apply under the following conditions:
  - He/ she is allowed to apply only via Embassy Track; and
  - The re-application is allowed only once.

#### 4. Grades

- Applicants must maintain a grade point average (GPA) higher than any ONE of the followings:
  - 2.64 on a 4.0 scale;
  - 2.80 on a 4.3 scale;
  - 2.91 on a 4.5 scale;
  - 3.23 on a 5.0 scale; or
  - Score percentile: 80%
- Please refer to the Appendix A for the GPA conversion table.
- Any applications with a GPA below the threshold above will be automatically disqualified and discarded.
- It is required to submit an official document issued by the applicant's *alma mater* describing the university's evaluation system as well as the applicant's academic achievement in any ONE of the following cases:
  - An applicant's transcript does not include information on GPA, marks or score percentile; or
  - The grades on an applicant's transcript are difficult to be converted into any one of the GPA criteria mentioned above.

#### 5. Health

- Applicants must be in good health, both mentally and physically, to stay in Korea for an extended period of time.
- Applicants must submit the Personal Medical Assessment, or Form 6, at the time of applying.
- All applicants who pass the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of selection must submit the results of the Comprehensive Medical Examination conducted by a licensed physician or a doctor.
- All of the following persons will be disqualified and their scholarships will be canceled:
  - Applicants who are tested positive on drugs; and
  - Applicants with serious health concerns to an extent that they are unable to pursue their studies for an extended period of time in Korea.
- Applicants with disability who meet the above criteria are eligible to apply.

#### 6. Restrictions

- Those who had withdrew from the scholarship after being selected as KGSP scholars in previous years are NOT eligible to apply.

#### 7. Preferred Qualities

- Applicants with certified scores on their proficiency in Korean or in English might be given preference. Some examples include the following:

- Proficiency in Korean: TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean)
- Proficiency in English: TOEFL, TOEIC, or IELTS Academic (TOEFL ITPs are not acceptable.)
- Applicants in the field of natural science, technology, and engineering might be given preference.
- Applicants for the majors under the *Industrial Professionals Training Project* of the government of Korea might be given preference.
- The faculty members at a higher education institution from countries that receive Korea's Official Development Assistance (ODA) might be given preference.
- Descendants of the Korean War veterans receive additional 5% of the total marks during the selection reviews.

## 2. Notes for All Applicants

- All application documents must be either in Korean or in English.
- Documents in any other languages must be accompanied by a complete Korean or English translation, authenticated by the issuing institution or notarized by a notary public.
- Submitted documents will not be returned to the applicants.
- Application documents must be presented in their original forms.
- The application documents must be submitted in the order of the checklist on the first page of the application form. Each required document must be numbered and labeled on the top right corner as the following.
  - Example: 9. Bachelor's Diploma
- In case of submitting photocopied documents, **applicants MUST have the copies notarized or apostilled** and then submit the notarized or apostilled copies.
- For any documents that cannot be reissued, applicants are advised to submit notarized or apostilled copies of the original.
- Applications that contain incomplete or forged documents will be disqualified and discarded.
- An applicant who is expected to graduate by August 31, 2017 must submit a certificate of expected degree in place of the diploma at the time of applying. The official diploma must be submitted by August 31, 2017.
- The recommendation letters must be written by two different recommenders, who can give assessment on the applicant's academic abilities.
- Applicants must get sealed recommendation letters from their recommenders. Letters with broken seals at the time of applying will be considered invalid.
- As for the submission of the published papers and awards, applicants are allowed to submit photocopies.
- The proof of citizenship must be the government-issued documents. Examples include, but are not limited to, the followings:
  - A birth certificate issued by the government of the applicant's country;
  - A certificate of family registration issued by the government of the applicant's country; or
  - Passport copies of the applicant and parents.
- The scores of the language proficiency test must be valid at the time of applying.

## 3. Embassy Track Application

- Applicants must submit ONE set of original application and THREE sets of photocopies, identical to the original set.
- For sealed documents, such as official transcripts and recommendation letters, applicants must submit 4 identical documents, each sealed in a separate envelope.

## 4. University Track Application

- Applicants must submit ONE original application documents.

## 5. Research Program Application

- Applicants must submit ONE original application documents.



## VI. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

### 1. How to Apply

- Applicants must apply for the Korean Government Scholarship Program either through the Korean Embassy in their home country or one of the selected universities.
- Offices accepting applications
  - **116 Embassies of the Republic of Korea:** At some embassies, the Korean Education Center or the Korean Cultural Center is the department in charge of accepting and reviewing the KGSP applications. Contacting the embassy to inquire on the department in charge is strongly recommended.
  - **65 Universities in Korea**
- The application submitted to more than ONE office above, will be automatically disqualified and discarded.
- Those who apply as overseas Korean adoptees must apply through the Korean Embassy in their home countries. Only those from the selected 12 countries are eligible to apply under this option.
- KGSP alumni are eligible to apply through the Embassy Track only.
- **Applicants from China** must submit their applications to the China Scholarship Council, in accordance with the agreement between the government of Korea and the government of China.
- **Applicants from the Czech Republic** must submit their applications to the Ministry of Education of the Czech Republic, in accordance with the agreement between the government of Korea and the government of the Czech Republic.

### 2. Deadline of Application Submission

- The deadlines are set by the Korean Embassies and universities that accept applications.
- Applicants must check the deadline of the embassy or of the university by contacting them directly.
- Please refer to the following:
  - Contact information for embassies: See Appendix B.
  - Contact information for universities: See Appendix C or the University Information file, announced along with the current application guidelines.

### 3. Fields of Study and University Choice

#### (1) Embassy Track

- Applicants must choose **THREE** desired universities as well as fields of study out of the 66 universities listed above in section III.
- Applications that pass the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of selection will be reviewed by the universities for admission. (Please refer to “4. Selection Procedure” below.)

#### (2) University Track

- Applicants must choose **ONE** desired university out of the 66 universities listed above in section III.

- (3) For the list of available universities and degree programs, please refer to the “University Information” file, announced along with the guidelines.

#### 4. Selection Procedure

##### 1<sup>st</sup> Round of Selection

Applications are submitted either to the Korean Embassies or to the designated universities in Korea. The embassies and universities select the successful candidates among the applicants in the 1st round of selection. The applications of the successful candidates will then be forwarded to NIIED.

- Embassies and Universities will forward the successful applications to NIIED by April 7, 2017.
- **Attention!** Applications arriving at NIIED after the above date will not be considered for review in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of selection, and the quotas will be substituted by the applications from other countries or universities.

##### 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of Selection

The NIIED Selection Committee selects the successful candidates among those who pass the 1st round.

- The University Track applicants who pass the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of selection will automatically be granted admission to the university. The University Track applicants will be selected as the final successful candidates **ONLY** after they submit their medical examination results.
- Comprehensive Medical Examination
  - All candidates who pass the 2nd round must get comprehensive medical exams as required by NIIED, and submit the results to NIIED.
  - The medical exams must be conducted by a licensed physician or a doctor.
  - The medical forms will be emailed to the successful candidates of the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of selection.
  - If the results show that the applicant is unfit to study and live overseas for an extended period of time, he/she will be disqualified.

##### 3<sup>rd</sup> Round of Selection (Embassy Track ONLY)

Among the successful candidates who have passed the 2nd round, the applications of those who applied through the Korean Embassies will be reviewed by universities for admission. Successful candidates must get admission from at least one of the universities.

#### 5. Selection Criteria: Comprehensive Evaluation

- The applications will be reviewed by a selection committee at each round.
- The selection committees will consider many elements in selecting successful candidates. Examples include, but are not limited to, the following:
  - transcript;
  - the letter of self-introduction;
  - the statement of purpose;
  - the letter of recommendation; and
  - certificates of language proficiency (Korean and English), publications, awards, etc.

- Airfare
  - Entry to Korea: an economy class flight ticket to Korea
  - Return flight: an economy class flight ticket from Korea to KGSP scholar's home country
  - The airfare for entry will NOT be provided to scholars who have resided in Korea from the time of applying and on.
  - The return flight is available only for the KGSP scholars who successfully complete their degree coursework.
  - The return flight is NOT offered for those who withdraw from the scholarship.
  - Any fees incurred in the domestic travel within a KGSP scholar's home country are NOT covered.
  - International travel insurance is NOT covered.
  - The flight tickets for the Chinese and Czech KGSP scholars will be prepared and provided by the Chinese and the Czech governments, according to the agreements with the Korean government.
- Settlement Allowance: 200,000 KRW
- Monthly Allowance
  - Degree Program (Master's or Doctoral): 900,000 KRW
  - Research Program: 1,500,000 KRW
- Research Allowance
  - Liberal Arts and Social Science Degrees: 210,000 KRW per semester
  - Science, Technology and Engineering Degrees: 240,000 KRW per semester
- Language Training Fees: Fully covered

- Degree Tuition: Fully covered
  - Tuition up to 5 million KRW is covered by NIIED, and the amount that exceeds 5 million is covered by the host university.
  - The KGSP scholars are waived from the admission fees of the universities.
- Dissertation Printing Fee Reimbursement
  - The actual cost of printing as written on the receipt will be reimbursed.
  - The maximum amount is 500,000 KRW for degrees in Liberal Arts and Social Science and 800,000 KRW for degrees in Science, Technology and Engineering.
- Medical Insurance: 20,000 KRW per month
- Korean Proficiency Grants: 100,000 KRW per month
  - This special funding is available for KGSP scholars with levels 5 and 6 on TOPIK.
- Scholarship Completion Grants: 200,000 KRW
  - It is offered for the KGSP scholars who return to their home countries after completing their degree coursework under the scholarship.
  - It is not offered for the KGSP scholars who decide to stay in Korea after the completion of their degree coursework.

## VIII. PERIOD OF SCHOLARSHIP

### 1. Master's Degree Program: 3 Years (September 1, 2017 – August 31, 2020)

- 1 Year Korean Language Program
- 2 Year Degree Program

### 2. Doctoral Degree Program: 4 Years (September 1, 2017 – August 31, 2021)

- 1 Year Korean Language Program
- 3 Year Degree Program

### 3. Research Program: 6 Months (September 1, 2017 – February 28, 2018)

### 4. Important Notes on the Scholarship Period.

- The scholarship period for the degree program cannot and will not be extended.
- The scholarship period for the language program will not affect the scholarship period for the degree program. For example, even if a scholar takes 6 months of the language program instead of 1 year, the period that the KGSP covers for his/her degree program will remain intact (2 years for Master's degree and 3 years for Doctoral degrees).
- KGSP scholars with advanced TOPIK levels (Levels 5 and 6)
  - Those who have the advanced levels at the time of applying will be exempt from the 1-year Korean language program. The exempt period will be deducted from the total scholarship period, down to 2 years for Master's degrees and to 3 years for Doctoral degrees.



- Those who achieve the advanced levels on TOPIK within the first 6 months of the language program will be exempt from the Korean language program and must start their degree programs in the following semester. The exempt period will be deducted from the total scholarship period, down to 2.5 years for Master's degrees and 3.5 years for Doctoral degrees.

## **IX. KOREAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM**

- All scholars, unless exempt, must take the 1-year Korean language program at language institutions assigned by NIIED.
- Exemption of the Korean language program
  - The KGSP scholars with advanced levels (5 & 6) on TOPIK at the time of applying will be exempt from the language program and must start their degree programs upon arriving in Korea.
  - The KGSP scholars who achieve advanced levels on TOPIK within the first 6 months of their language program, will be exempt from it in the following semester and must start their degree programs.
  - A valid TOPIK certificate must be submitted to NIIED.
- When assigning the language institution, NIIED considers the following:
  - The language institution is not located in the same city as the scholar's degree university; and
  - The language institution offers a variety of opportunities for the scholars to learn different local cultures of Korea.
- The language institution for successful KGSP scholars will be announced along with the final results.
- Note that the assigned language institution cannot and will not be changed.
- The KGSP scholars in the Korean language program must live on-campus at the language institutions.
  - Most rooms of the university dormitories are shared with roommates.
  - Living with family members is strictly forbidden.
  - Scholars with TOPIK level 3 or higher are eligible to live off-campus.
- Prerequisites to complete the language program
  - The KGSP scholars must obtain at least level 3 on TOPIK by the end of the 1-year Korean language program, in order to be able to proceed to their degree programs.

## **X. OTHER IMPORTANT NOTES**

### **1. Medical Insurance**

- Universities and language institutions will purchase medical insurance plans on behalf of the KGSP scholars.
- The insurance plan will be effective after the designated dates of arrival.
- The medical fees incurred throughout the scholarship period will be reimbursed by the insurance company.
  - KGSP scholars must pay for the hospital fees first and submit the receipt to the insurance company
  - The insurance company will refund part of the fees. It is the KGSP scholars' responsibility to check the insurance terms and policies, which will be given through the universities and language institutions.



- The medical insurance will not cover the expenses for dental or chronic diseases.

## 2. Scholarship Withdrawal or Cancellation

- The KGSP scholars who forfeit and withdraw from the scholarship will NOT receive the returning flight tickets or the Scholarship Completion Grants.
- The KGSP scholars who forfeit and withdraw from the scholarship within the first 3 months after the entry to Korea MUST return the scholarship fees that they have received during the mentioned period. It will include the airfare of the entry ticket to Korea, the settlement allowance, monthly allowance, medical insurance fees, and tuition.

## 3. Restriction on Changing Universities and Degrees

- Transferring to a different university under this scholarship is NOT permitted in any case.
- Changing majors may be possible in limited situations only, including but not limited to the following:
  - with the approval of the applicant’s university and concerned departments; or
  - with the scholarship period unchanged. (2 years for Master’s and 3 years for Doctoral)

# 2017 Korean Government Scholarship Program for Graduate Degrees: FAQ

## ELIGIBILITY

**Q1**

I am currently enrolled at a university in Korea for a Master's degree. Am I eligible to apply for the Master's degree program under KGSP?

**A1**

Yes, you are eligible to apply for our scholarship program as long as you have not achieved degrees. Those who have taken classes at universities in Korea or participated in exchange student programs in Korea, therefore, may apply for KGSP. However, if you are selected as a 2017 KGSP scholar, then you must drop out of the program you are currently enrolled.

**Q2**

I am enrolled at a last semester at one of the Korean universities for a Bachelor's degree program. Am I eligible to apply for a Master's degree under KGSP?

**A2**

No, you are not. In order to apply for a Master's degree program, you must (or are expected to) have at least a Bachelor's degree. Since you will be getting your Bachelor's degree in Korea, you are not eligible to apply for a Master's degree program under KGSP.

**Q3**

I am enrolled at a last semester at one of the Korean universities for a Master's degree program. Am I eligible to apply for a Doctoral degree under KGSP?

**A3**

No, you are not. In order to apply for a Doctoral degree program, you must (or are expected to) have at least a Master's degree. Since you will be getting your Master's degree in Korea, you are not eligible to apply for a Doctoral degree program under KGSP.

**Q4**

I am expected to complete my Master's degree in August 2017. Am I eligible to apply for a Doctoral degree program under this scholarship?

**A4**

If you submit an official certificate of expected graduation or a provisional degree certificate issued by the university, you may apply for the 2017 KGSP. However, it is allowed in condition that the final degree certificate will be submitted to NIIED by August 31, 2017. The failure of doing so will result in the cancelation of the scholarship.

## APPLICATION SUBMISSION

**Q5**

May I apply for the program through the NIIED directly?

**A5**

No you may not. Applications must be submitted either to the Korean Embassy in your home country or to one of the designated Korean universities. Make sure to refer to the information on the application guidelines on how to submit your application. Also note that you may not submit your application to the embassy of your country in Korea.

**Q6**

When is the deadline for application?

**A6**

Each Korean Embassy and university decides its own deadline. Although most deadlines fall between late February and March, you must contact the Korean Embassy in your home country or the university of your choice, regarding the deadline.

**Q7**

Where can I submit my application?

**A7**

All applications must be submitted to the institutions of the 1st round of selection, which means the Korean Embassies or the Korean universities. Before submitting your application, you must carefully study the 2017 KGSP Application Guidelines, available on [www.studyinkorea.go.kr](http://www.studyinkorea.go.kr). Please note that you must submit your application either to the Korean Embassy in your home country or to one of the designated Korean universities, not both.

**Q8**

I am a Korean adoptee who has a foreign nationality. Where can I submit my application for the KGSP graduate program?

**A8**

There is a separate quota assigned for the Overseas Korean Adoptees under the Embassy Track. The Korean adoptees from the countries selected by NIIED are eligible to apply under this option. If you hold the nationality of one of the selected countries, you may apply through the Korean Embassy in your country. A total of 14 persons will be selected under the Overseas Korean Adoptees option.

**Q9**

Should I submit the certificates of language proficiency (English or Korean) when I apply for the KGSP?

**A9**

The certificate of English proficiency (TOEFL or IELTS) or Korean proficiency (TOPIK) is an optional document, which means you may apply for KGSP without it. However, those with the language proficiency certificate will be given preferences in the selection procedure. It is also important to note that some embassies and universities **DO REQUIRE** the language proficiency certificate for all applicants.

**Q10**

What should put in the section of GPA on the Application Form?

**A10**

Please put your GPA or scores for each semester. If you have completed your undergraduate program with 8 semesters for 4 years, write your GPA or scores of each semester in the blank. Make sure to put your GPA in front of the slash (/), and the full GPA behind the slash (/). For example, if your GPA is 3.5 out of 4.5, you must put 3.5/ 4.5.

**Q11**

How many recommendation letters should I submit?

**A11**

NIIED requires **TWO** letters of recommendation. It is highly advised that applications ask their professors and academic advisors for the letters. However, in case the university of your choice asks for more letters of recommendation, you must submit additional letters.

**Q12**

Should I include a detailed research proposal in the Statement of Purpose?

**A12**

Yes. You must at least describe the general direction and outlines of your study plans, if not in full detail. Please elaborate on your study objectives in Korea, tangible plans during and after your degree program.

**Q13**

I will apply through the Embassy Track. According to the guidelines, I have to submit 4 sets of application documents: 1 original and 3 photocopies. How may I submit the sealed documents, such as transcripts and recommendation letters?

**A13**

Please submit **FOUR** identical documents, each sealed in a separate envelope. For all other documents that are not sealed, you can make photocopies of the original.

**Q14**

Can I submit the documents that are in languages other than Korean or English?

**A14**

KGSP requires that all documents be translated into Korean or English, and then be authenticated by the issuing institution or by a notary public. If your country has joined the apostille convention, you can get your document apostilled.

**Q15**

I am a Japanese citizen, currently working in Vietnam. May I apply for the program through the Korean Embassy in Vietnam?

**A15**

No, you may not. If you choose to apply in the Embassy Track, you must submit your application to the Korean Embassy in Japan. In addition, those who hold the citizenship of the countries to which the KGSP quota is not assigned, are unable to apply for KGSP through the Korean Embassies in those countries.

**Q16**

I am a Chinese citizen. In the application guidelines, there is quota only assigned in the Embassy Track for the Chinese citizens. Does that mean that I must apply at the Korean Embassy in China?

**A16**

No, you should not submit your application to the Korean Embassy in China. According to the mutual agreement between Korea and China, Chinese applicants should submit their application to China Scholarship Council (CSC) affiliated with Ministry of Education in China. Likewise, the Czech citizens should also submit the application to their Ministry of Education according to the mutual agreement between the governments of Korea and Czech Republic.

**Q17**

I am American living in Los Angeles, United States. I am going to apply for the program via the Korea Embassy. How should I submit my application to the Embassy in Washington D.C.?

**A17**

You can submit your application to your nearest Korean Consulate. In case of you, you can submit it to the Korea Consulate in LA. Embassy in Washington and regional Consulates in the United States will cooperate to select the prospective candidates. This arrangement is available only for the United States.

## CHOICE OF UNIVERSITY & MAJOR

**Q18**

May I choose any field of study for a Master's (or Doctoral) degree program?

**A18**

You may choose the majors and programs listed in the University Information announced on our website, [www.studyinkorea.go.kr](http://www.studyinkorea.go.kr). Although it is not required, it is highly recommended that you apply for a major that is in the same field of study as your previous degree. For example, those who majored in economics for undergraduate degrees are recommended to apply for a Master's degree in economics. NIIED is unable to be held responsible for any disadvantage arising from applying for a field in which an applicant has no prior experience. NIIED strongly recommends that you contact the universities to consult on the majors and degree programs you are interested in.

**Q19**

How many majors and universities can I apply for admission?

**A19**

If you apply in the University Track, you may choose only ONE university and ONE major. If you apply in the Embassy Track, you may choose THREE universities and the majors offered at each university. Note that you may not choose three different majors from a single university. Please refer to the application guidelines and the university information.

**Q20**

I am from Mongolia and I want to apply for Master's degree in Electronic Engineering. Would I stand a better chance to be selected if I apply for regional universities other than non-regional universities?

**A20**

Not really. The Ministry of Education in Korea has created a separate admission track for regional universities, especially in the field of Natural Science and Engineering, as part of the endeavor to attract talented students at those universities.

What can be said at this point, however, is that the application of those who apply for a degree program in the field of science and engineering at a regional university, might be given additional consideration, depending on the applicant's country of origin. For example, the University Track quota for Mongolian applicants is 10. Out of the total 10, 4 will be selected among all fields. The remaining 6 will be selected among the applicants in the science and engineering fields. That is to say, the applicants in the field of science and technology have double chances to be considered in the selection procedure. Since not all applicants will have this second chance, it is highly recommended to check the quota table in the application guidelines.

**Q21**

I am from Malaysia. May I apply for a major in the field of Liberal Arts and Social Science at one of the regional universities?

**A21**

Yes, you may as long as the university of your choice offers a degree program for KGSP scholars. You are eligible to apply for any degree program listed in the University Information. Therefore, you are free to choose to apply for any one of the 65 designated universities, both regional and non-regional alike.

However, out of the total quota of 7 assigned for the University Track applicants from Malaysia, 4 will be selected from all range of available majors because 3 is reserved for the applicants in the field of science and engineering.

**Q22**

I am going to apply for the program via Embassy Track. Application guidelines say that applicants should choose up to 3 preferred universities and departments (or majors). Do you have any useful tips on choosing those universities and majors?

**A22**

First, make sure to carefully study the application guidelines and the University Information. Then feel free to contact the university of your interest for further inquiries. You have to bear in mind that passing the 2nd round of selection will not guarantee an admission to the university that you chose. The admission rate for the successful candidates of the 2nd round is about 80%. It might be wise to broaden your scope on the universities since each university has its strength and specialize in different fields. You would want to check which university is the leading institution in the field of study you would like to pursue for your graduate degree.

## **KOREAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM**

**Q23**

Is it mandatory for all KGSP scholars to pass at least Level 3 in TOPIK after one year of Korean Language Course?

**A23**

Yes, it is. A KGSP scholar must get at least Level 3 on TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean) by the end of the 1-year Korean language program in order to proceed to his or her degree program.

Please note that NIIED will assign the language institution for each KGSP scholar with various factors in consideration, and the assignment of language institution will not and cannot be altered. Through the language program, scholars are required to live on-campus of the language institution and it is strictly forbidden to live with family members.

**Q24**

May I be exempt from the Korean Language Course?

**A24**

If you have an advanced level (Levels 5 or 6) on TOPIK, you are exempted from the language course and you must start your degree course starting from the following semester of the date you achieve the advanced level on TOPIK. In addition, you will receive the Korean Proficiency Grant of 100,000 KRW per month.

## **DEGREE PROGRAM**

**Q25**

May I change my final choice of a university for a graduate degree during the preliminary Korean language course?

**A25**

No, you may not. Changing the university or transferring to another university is **NOT PERMITTED** under any circumstances. Changing a major, however, might be allowed very limitedly, provided the related departments of the university agree to the change of your major.

**Q26**

Is it possible to extend my scholarship period for completing my thesis (or dissertation) beyond the designated period?

**A26**

No, it is not. According to the KGSP Academic Regulations amended in 2012, the KGSP scholars from 2012 are not allowed to extend the scholarship period.

## 지원자격

Q1

한국에서 석사과정에 다니고 있는 학생입니다. KGSP 석사과정에 지원 할 수 있습니까?

A1

지원할 수 있습니다. 한국에서 학부나 대학원을 졸업한 사실이 없다면 KGSP 학위과정에 지원할 수 있습니다. 한국에서 학위과정 경험자나 교환학생 경험자도 지원 가능합니다. 단, 2017 KGSP 장학생으로 선발될 경우, 기존에 다니고 있던 학위과정은 모두 포기하시고 새로 시작하셔야 합니다.

Q2

한국에서 학사과정 마지막 학기인 학생입니다. KGSP 석사과정에 지원 할 수 있습니까?

A2

지원하실 수 없습니다. KGSP 석사 과정에 지원하시기 위해서는 최소한 학사 학위를 제출하셔야 하며, 한국에서 취득하거나 취득 예정인 학사 학위 소지자는 지원하실 수 없습니다.

Q3

한국에서 석사과정 마지막 학기인 학생입니다. KGSP 박사과정에 지원 할 수 있습니까?

A3

지원하실 수 없습니다. KGSP 박사 과정에 지원하시기 위해서는 최소한 석사 학위를 제출하셔야 하며, 한국에서 취득하거나 취득 예정인 석사 학위 소지자는 지원하실 수 없습니다.

Q4

석사과정이 2017년 8월에 끝나는데 2017 KGSP 박사과정에 지원 할 수 있습니까?

A4

현재 재학 중인 대학에서 장학생 지원기한 내에 석사학위 졸업예정증명서를 받아 제출하면 지원가능 합니다. 그러나 졸업예정증명서를 제출하고 장학생에 합격한 사람은 2017년 8월 31일까지 반드시 공식 졸업증명서를 NIIED에 제출하여야 하며, 그러지 못할 경우 장학생 자격이 취소됩니다.

# 지원서류

**Q5**

NIIED로 지원서를 바로 제출해도 됩니까?

**A5**

아닙니다. 지원서는 반드시 1차 선발기관(재외공관 혹은 KGSP 수석대학)으로 제출해야 합니다. 제출 방법에 대해서는 모집요강을 참고 바랍니다. 한국에 있는 지원자 출신 국가 대사관으로도 지원서를 제출할 수 없습니다.

**Q6**

지원서 제출 마감일이 언제입니까?

**A6**

정확한 마감기한 일은 1차 선발기관에서 2017년 2월 혹은 3월 중에 별도 날짜를 지정합니다. 그러므로 정확한 마감기한을 알기 위해 지원서를 제출 할 해당 1차 선발기관에 직접 문의하시길 바랍니다.

**Q7**

지원서는 어디로 제출하면 됩니까?

**A7**

지원자들은 '1차 선발기관'에 지원을 해야 합니다. '1차 선발기관'에는, 재외 한국대사관과 국내 대학이 있습니다. 지원자들은 지원서를 제출할 1차 선발기관을 결정하기 전에 반드시 모집요강을 자세히 읽어보아야 합니다. 모집요강은 GKS 홈페이지([www.studyinkorea.go.kr](http://www.studyinkorea.go.kr))에 게시되어 있습니다. 그리고 지원서 제출은 오직 한 기관을 통해서만 가능합니다.

**Q8**

외국국적의 한국인 입양인은 어디에 서류를 제출합니까?

**A8**

해외 입양인은 별도 선발하고 있으며, 입양인 지원은 먼저 본인의 국적 국가가 입양인 배정인원을 받아야 하고, 그 후에 자국의 한국대사관을 통해서 신청하시면 됩니다. 입양인은 전체 선발인원의 14명까지 선발합니다.

**Q9**

언어능력 증명서(영어, 한국어)는 꼭 제출해야 합니까?

**A9**

영어능력시험 증명서(TOEFL, IELTS)와 한국어능력시험 증명서(TOPIK)는 KGSP 지원 시에 선택사항이며 의무사항이 아닙니다. 그러므로 언어능력증명서 없이도 지원은 가능합니다. 그러나 제출 시에는 선발에 우선 선발조건으로 적용되며, 1차 추천기관에서는 언어능력 증명서를 장학생 추천을 위해 요구할 수도 있습니다. 한편, 2차 합격 후 대학에 진학을 위해 입학 허가를 신청할 때도 특정 학과에서는 별도로 어학 능력을 요구 할 수도 있습니다.

**Q10**

지원서(Application Form)의 성적(GPA)란에는 무엇을 기재합니까?

**A10**

각각 해당학기의 본인의 GPA 또는 점수를 기재하면 됩니다. 만약에 학부과정을 4년 동안 8학기(4년)로 졸업했다면 각 8학기의 GPA 또는 점수를 각각의 빈칸(/)에 기재하면 됩니다. 빈칸의 /앞에는 본인의 GPA 또는 점수를, /뒤에는 만점 GPA 또는 점수를 기재합니다.  
예) 3.5/4.5 또는 85/100

**Q11**

추천서는 몇 부를 제출해야 합니까?

**A11**

지원자는 기본적으로 2부의 추천서를 제출합니다. 그리고 추천서는 이전에 재학했던 학교의 교수님으로부터 받는 게 좋습니다. 그런데 3차 대학입학전형 시 지방 대학으로부터 추가로 추천서를 요구할 시 그 대학에 추가 추천서를 제출할 수도 있습니다.

**Q12**

학업 계획서(Statement of Purpose)에 구체적인 학업계획(proposal)을 포함해야 합니까?

**A12**

예, 구체적인 학업계획은 아니더라도 대체적인 학업계획은 제시해야 합니다. 즉, 한국에서의 학업 목표와 계획, 그리고 학업 후 계획 등을 제시하면 됩니다.

**Q13**

공관전형 지원자의 경우, 서류 제출 시 원본 1부 및 복사본 3부를 제출하도록 되어 있는데, 봉인된 성적증명서와 추천서는 어떻게 복사하여 제출합니까?

**A13**

발급받은 서류 중 봉인된 서류(성적증명서 및 추천서 등)는 각 4부를 준비하여 제출하시길 바랍니다. 서류는 별도의 봉투에 봉인되어야 합니다. 그 외 봉인되지 않은 서류는 반드시 지원자 본인이 3부 복사하여 원본과 함께 제출해야 합니다.

**Q14**

서류가 영어 또는 한국어로 되어 있지 않은 경우에는 어떻게 제출합니까?

**A14**

지원 서류가 영어 또는 한국어로 되어 있지 않은 경우에는 반드시 번역을 해야 하며, 번역본이 원본과 동일함을 증명하는 공증을 한국공관 또는 공증사무소를 통해 받아야 합니다. 만일 해당 국가가 '아포스티유(apostille)' 가입국가라면 아포스티유 확인을 받아도 됩니다. 아포스티유 확인을 받을 때 서류가 영어가 아니라면 아포스티유 확인을 받은 서류를 공증 받아야 합니다.

**Q15**

저는 일본 국적이지만 현재 베트남에서 거주하고 있습니다. 지원서를 베트남대사관에 제출해도 됩니까?

**A15**

불가능합니다. 공관을 통해 지원할 경우 반드시 자국에 있는 한국대사관에 지원해야 합니다. 덧붙인다면, 자신의 국가의 한국대사관에 장학생 인원이 배정되지 않았다면, 그 한국대사관엔 장학생 선발권이 없습니다.

**Q16**

저는 중국국적의 지원자입니다. 중국의 경우는 공관추천만 있는데, 그럼 중국에 있는 한국대사관에 지원을 합니까?

**A16**

아닙니다. 중국은 한국과의 협정에 의해 중국 교육부에서 서류를 접수하여 1차 선발하도록 되어 있습니다. 그러므로 중국지원자들은 중국 교육부의 **국가유학기금관리위원회(China Scholarship Council)**로 지원해야 합니다.

체코도 중국과 동일하게 **체코 교육부**에서 1차 선발을 하므로 체코 교육부로 서류를 제출해야 합니다.

**Q17**

저는 미국 LA에 거주하고 있는 미국지원자입니다. 공관을 통해 이 프로그램에 지원하고 싶은데, 지원 서류를 워싱턴의 한국대사관에 제출해야 합니까?

**A17**

미국의 경우는 지역간 거리가 너무 멀기 때문에 자기 지역에 있는 한국총영사관에 지원서류를 제출하면 됩니다. 워싱턴에 있는 한국대사관에서 지역의 총영사관과 협의하여 지원서류를 처리할 것입니다.

## 대학 및 전공 선택

**Q18**

석사나 박사과정 지원 할 때 어떤 분야든지 지원 할 수 있습니까?

**A18**

NIIED 홈페이지(<http://www.studyinkorea.go.kr>)에 게재된 'University Information'에 제공된 학과 중에서만 지원할 수 있습니다. 지원학과는 본인 학위과정의 전공과 동일한 전공을 지원하길 권합니다. 예를 들어, 학부에서 경제학을 공부한 경우 석사과정은 경제학을 선택하길 권합니다. 그렇지 않으면 대학으로부터 입학허가를 받지 못할 수가 있습니다. 전공 선택에 대해서는 반드시 지원하고자 하는 대학의 학과와 상담을 하고 지원하길 바랍니다.

**Q19**

대학입학을 위하여 몇 개의 대학과 전공에 지원 할 수 있습니까?

**A19**

국내 위탁대학을 통해 지원하는 지원자는 지원서를 제출하는 하나의 대학과 그 대학에서 제공하는 하나의 전공만 선택할 수 있습니다.

재외공관을 통해 지원하는 지원자는 "University Information"에 있는 대학 중 3개의 대학에 지원하되, 각 대학별로 하나의 전공만 선택할 수 있습니다. 자세한 내용은 다음 모집요강을 참고하시기 바랍니다.

**Q20**

저는 몽골 국적의 지원자로 전자공학 석사과정을 지원하려고 하는데 서울에 있는 대학보다 지방에 있는 대학에 지원하는 것이 더 유리한가요?

**A20**

단정적으로 말할 수는 없습니다. 한국의 교육부에서는 우수한 이공계 장학생을 지방에 많이 유치하기 위해서 이공계 지원트랙을 만들어서 시행하고 있습니다.

몽골의 대학교 선발인원 10명 중 4명은 전공 구분 없이 선발하고, 나머지 6명은 지방대 이공계 지원자들만을 대상으로 선발하기 때문에 이공계 학생들은 한 번의 기회를 더 가질 수는 있다고 말씀드릴 수 있습니다.

**Q21**

저는 말레이시아 국적의 지원자 입니다. 지방대 전형 대학에 속한 대학의 인문 사회계열에는 지원할 수 없습니까?

**A21**

지원할 수 있습니다. 지원자는 65개 대학 중 정부초청장학생에게 개설한 전 학문분야를 지원할 수 있습니다. 우수한 인문사회계열 지원자는 지원에 제한이 없으므로 수도권이든 지방이든 소신껏 지원하면 됩니다.

다만 말레이시아 장학생을 선발 할 때, 말레이시아의 배정 인원 7명 중 4명을 전공 구분 없이 먼저 선발하고, 나머지 학생 중에서 지방대학교 이공계 지원자 3명을 선발합니다.

**Q22**

저는 공관을 통해서 이 프로그램에 지원하려고 합니다. 이때 대학을 3개까지 선택을 해야 하는데, 어떻게 하는 것이 가장 좋을까요?

**A22**

공관을 통하여 지원하는 지원자는 대학 선택에 주의를 해야 합니다. KGSP 장학생 2차 전형에 합격했다고 대학에서 입학허가를 해주는 것은 아닙니다. 2차 합격생의 대학 입학 합격률은 80%정도 입니다.

대학 선택에 있어 시야를 넓게 가지고 판단하는 자세가 필요합니다. 한국의 모든 대학은 각자의 강점과 특성화 분야가 있습니다. 관심 있는 대학이 강점을 갖고 있는 분야가 무엇인지 알아보시고, 본인이 지원하고자 하는 분야에서 우수한 실적을 보이는 대학을 찾아보신다면 많은 도움이 될 것입니다.

## 한국어연수

**Q23**

KGSP 학생들은 한국어연수 후에 반드시 TOPIK 3급 이상을 취득해야 합니까?

**A23**

네 필수사항입니다. 만일 1년의 한국어연수 후에도 TOPIK(Test of Proficiency in Korean) 3급을 취득하지 못할 시에는 학위과정에 진학할 수 없으며, 장학생자격이 취소됩니다.

또한, 한국어연수기관은 10개 내외의 거점연수기관 중, NIIED가 결정하며, 배치된 한국어연수기관은 변경할 수 없습니다. 한국어연수기간 동안에는 집중적인 한국어연수를 위해 가족동반을 금지하며, 배치된 연수기관의 기숙사 생활을 원칙으로 합니다.

**Q24**

한국어연수를 면제받을 수 있나요?

**A24**

지원 당시에 이미 TOPIK 5급 혹은 6급을 취득한 경우에는 한국어 연수를 면제 받고 바로 9월에 시작하는 학위과정을 시작해야만 합니다. 또한, 한국어연수 중에 TOPIK 5급 이상을 취득한 후 차년도 3월부터 한국어연수를 면제받을 수 있습니다. 한국어연수를 면제받는 경우 NIIED의 허가를 얻어 바로 학위과정에 진학해야 합니다. 또한 학위과정 진학 후부터 TOPIK 5급 이상 취득자는 매달 100,000원의 추가 장학금을 받을 수 있습니다.

## 학위과정

**Q25**

2017년도 대학원장학생으로 학위과정 중에 대학과 전공을 변경할 수 있습니까?

**A25**

변경할 수 없습니다. 학위과정 대학은 장학생으로 합격 후 종료 시까지 절대 변경할 수 없습니다. 단, 학과는 동일 대학 내에서 이전학과와 신규학과 상호 동의 하에 대학의 허가를 얻을 경우에만 변경할 수 있습니다.

**Q26**

학위과정 종료 후 논문작성을 위하여 장학기간을 연장할 수 있습니까?

**A26**

개정된 규정(2012년도)에 의하여 2012년도 대학원장학생부터 학위과정 종료 후 장학기간 연장을 할 수 없습니다. (2017학년도 대학원장학생 포함 장학기간 연장 불가)
