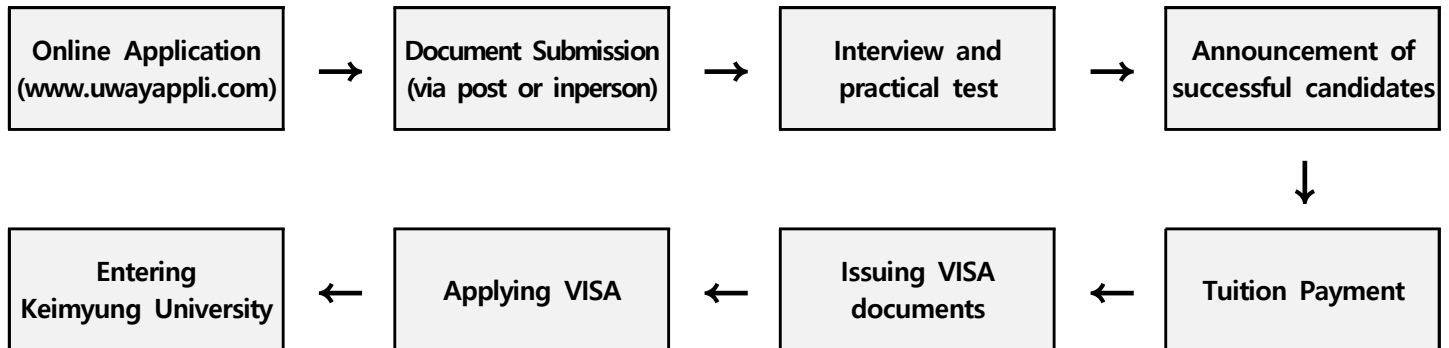

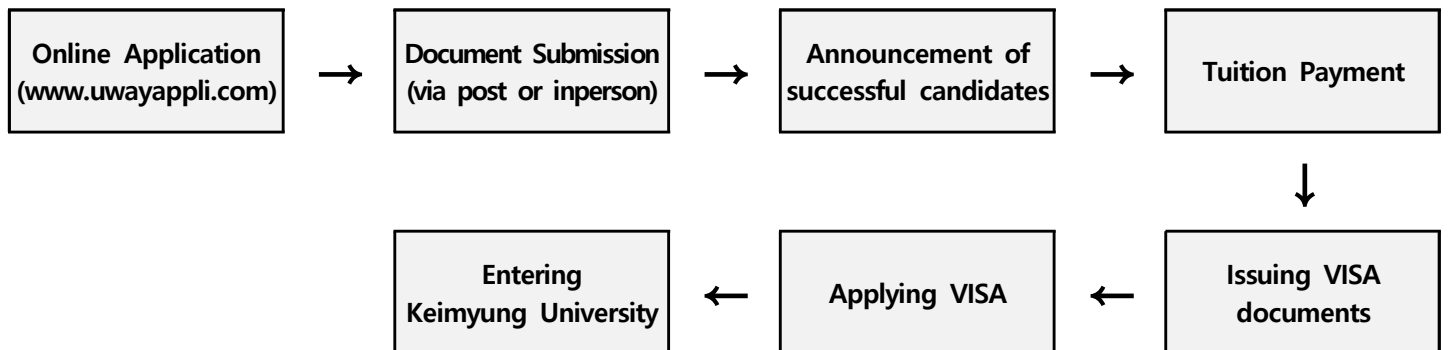


■ Admission Process

- If you turned in expected graduation or completion certificate, you must submit the final documents before the last day of February. If the documents cannot be submitted by the time, your admission will be canceled. ※ In case of the applicants who are completing high school or university in Japan, you are able to send us the final documents within 8 weeks from the beginning of the semester.
- Keimyung University is able to ask additional documents which are not on the list if it is necessary.
- The contact information has to be accurate since we are delivering important messages regarding the admission.

- We do not reveal the evaluation specifics.
- The students below will be rejected
 - ▶ Who cannot satisfy the requirements, and fail to submit the documents
 - ▶ Who cannot earn higher than 40% from the interview or 60% from practical test
 - ▶ Who cannot attend the interview or practical test.
- If there is any problem which is not written on the guidelines, the admission will be decided based on the school regulation.
